

**Update:** June 13, 2024

Beloved Friends and Intercessors For Ireland,

As we quickly enter into the second half of 2024, I wanted to share a mid-year ministry update. First and foremost, though, I want to thank everyone that has been praying, standing and supporting us, as we have been in a season of waiting. That despite what our eyes have seen or what our flesh has felt during this time, Yeshua has been with us—close like no other. He continues to establish our steps while in this place of being exposed, yet hidden. We can only give Him all the praise, glory and honour, knowing that we can do nothing of our own abilities!

With that said, earlier in the year while on a prayer walk, the rain was threatening to come and I had asked the One Who is the Storm to make it go away, as I was weary and not feeling up to contending with the elements that day. As the wind blew and the rain started to pelt against me, while in the most exposed area of my walk—open land and on the highest point, I asked again, *“Lord, make it go away – You are the Storm, all things come from You and return to You, make it go away.”* I then promptly heard the Lord speak, *“Tracy, just endure.”*

Those words quickly reminded me of a struggle that I had gone through while on a 40-day fast, when I felt as if I could not complete the last ten days. It was an unusual struggle, as I had not ever had such a challenge like that in previous years during those 40-days of fasting. But it was the Lord’s divine design to remind me of our need to be utterly dependent upon Him, wanting me to feel, again, how truly worthless our strength, our wisdom and our ways are in His Kingdom. I had almost quit that fast, as those last ten days felt like eternity to overcome. The only reason that I did not quit, was because I knew He had asked me to do those 40-days. If I had quit, then I would have failed to obey the only One Who is worthy. In the struggle, I resolved not to make it about me—what I feel or think. When I did, the Lord quickly caused rivers of grace to flow, enabling me to effortlessly complete the remaining ten days.

Moments after the breakthrough came, the Holy Spirit spoke saying, *“When we quit, we make it about ‘me’ and not about Him—His abilities to pull us through.”* And, now, the Lord was telling me, *“Just endure”* as the elements assaulted me from every side. To endure means: to suffer through something difficult, unpleasant or painful. Enduring enables us to persevere and that perseverance produces character—the fruit of the Spirit in our lives. Endurance takes patience. Both, endurance and patience, are a mark of strength and not weakness, and most times developed in our soul when we feel so weak—when we want to give up, give in or give over to life’s circumstances!

For the promises of God to be fulfilled in our lives and to run our race successfully, it takes faith, endurance and patience. If we do not endure through the difficult, unpleasant and painful times that come into our lives, we will not finish our race. If we are not patient, we will not endure. It is not a sprint but a long-distance race that we are all called to run. Yet, many fail to finish because endurance has not been forged into their souls. The good seeds sown into their lives fell on the rocky places causing them to give up by putting their hope in man’s ways and not God’s ways. Nothing proves our faith, endurance and patience more than by the relationships that we have with others. Those relationships expose our character flaws and our desperate need of a Savior to be made Lord and King over every area of our lives. It is often through relationships with others where we feel as if we have been destroyed. Yet, at the same time by divine design, it is through relationship where we are healed, and not by living in isolation. If we choose isolation, we will cause our wounds to become idols, not allowing Him to pull us through the difficult, unpleasant and painful situations that are meant to bring newness and fullness of life.

Derek Prince once said, *“Paul, makes it clear that the first fruit or sign of an apostolic ministry is not signs and wonders, but endurance. The apostle is the one that hangs out when everyone else gives up.”* Endurance always comes before the miracles that are to take place in a vessel who is truly a ‘sent one’ by the Lord.

Beloveds, as the darkness increases, may a spirit of endurance do its good work in our souls that we can become those vessels of mercy, that have been prepared beforehand, who will display His glory to a lost world all around us. May it be for the fame of His name and the advancement of His Kingdom to go forth from our lives, all for His glory and not ours!

**In that place of enduring, I would like to share the following with you:**

- 1. January, February, March**, has been a time of waiting, yet watching in that place of intercessory prayer. In March, I was blessed to partake and lead the time of prayer at a prophetic prayer meeting with other beloved sons and daughters in Co. Mayo, who are contending for the destiny of this nation to fulfilled. Soon after, the Lord revealed that I was in a place of being exposed, yet to stay hidden, and to stay one step ahead of death. I had no idea how true that word would become in the weeks following.
- 2. April, May**, after hosting our Passover Seder, I hit a physical wall. The Lord had a marvelous way of helping me stay in that place of hiddenness. I had not realised how 'worn out' I had become from eight plus years of hard labour ploughing up fallow ground in this land. It all snowballed by causing my adrenals to become fatigued and manifesting through my eye. It has been a challenging time, yet, the Lord has been only faithful to direct my steps of recovery. The M-W-F prayer calls and bi-weekly watches came to a pause for two-weeks while seeking rest and healing. My eye has greatly improved, and the adrenals will take some time, but moving in the right the direction. Two days before our Seder, I got news that my rent was increasing 50%—that probably did not help much!
- 3. June**, our June 3rd, 5th and 7th calls were two hours+ each to pray for our local and EU elections. Each time we covered the issues that needed covered, first, in our priestly roles through Identification Repentance, so that we could walk in our kingly roles. The Lord gave us divine strategies not only for Ireland but for all of Europe. We were able to pray into a dream that I had been given in 2020, where darkness was covering Europe, and for faith to arise, by calling out the EU Nations by name. As a nation, we have a long way to go, but the Lord was gracious. Our prayers were not only heard but answered. The Master Chess Player re-arranged the pawns on the chessboard of Ireland's destiny and caused Sinn Féin and The Green Party to suffer great loss. Ireland's two incumbent Green Party MEPs lost their seats and The Greens overall took a big hit throughout Europe, restoring hope to farmers. We saw 'faith arise' over Europe as the people are fighting to take back their God given Identities. We are seeing, for the first time, a conservative voice coming forth. A heart felt thank you to everyone who sacrificed their time to join this appointed time of prayer, calling forth Ireland to fulfill her destiny to be light to the European nations.

- 6. HOP:** We keep praying for an increase in the number of Intercessors For Ireland who will join the HOP until they are 24/7, by committing to a 3-hour watch. We stand in awe of those who have been faithful, focused and committed to keep watch. Eternally grateful for their hearts of prayer! We continue to provide monthly prayer points.
- 7. Up until June 10th**, we have kept a Tuesday and Thursday prayer watch and a monthly corporate watch. From June 10–July 6, we will only be doing a weekly Tuesday corporate watch and our monthly prayer watch.

**As we move forward, your prayers and support are needed:**

**1. Pray that TVOMB would be filled with the knowledge of His will** in all wisdom and spiritual understanding, that we may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God, strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power [Colossians 1:9-11].

**2. Pray for blessings, protection, strength, healing and provision for those keeping watches and their families:** That no weapon formed against them will prosper — for divine health and protection!

**3. Pray for the laborers to come forth:** Those who will rebuild the broken-down walls in our nation God's way. Those who will be like Joshua and Caleb, who are of a different spirit and who will follow the Lord wholeheartedly.

**4. M-W-F prayer calls:** That every eternal purpose for why do them will be fulfilled. For seeds sown to bear 100% fruit, for the laborers to unite, arise and build. That a pure and spotless Bride will come forth!
